Dear Ms. Des Rosiers,

Thank you for your attention in trying to improve the factual information of my blog.

In your email you do not deny that you played a part in the university cover up of the covert surveillance matter, as I state on my blog.

In my blog posts in question, you will note that "the university officials who supervised the spying" are differentiated from those "who appear to be participating in the cover up". I have stated that you are part of the latter group.

As explained in item-6 of my letter to you of November 11, 2009 ([also posted on my blog](#)), this is based on my unanswered June 26, 2009, detailed request to you ([again posted on my blog](#)), as VP-Governance, that you investigate the covert surveillance matter. You never acknowledged my June 26, 2009, formal request nor, to my knowledge, did you act upon it.

The latter professional omissions on your part were in violation of your responsibilities as VP-Governance and constituted an element of a university cover up that has lasted to this day. Surely as chief of the Canadian Civil Liberties Association you appreciate that a university's covert information gathering campaign against several students and a professor (and its cover up) are serious matters of civil liberties and academic freedom that merit a university investigation.

As an employee in high standing at the University of Ottawa, you continue to be in a position to recommend that the required (under Policy 92) university investigation be undertaken. You could even do so publicly. I would further advance that as a lawyer you have a professional ethics responsibility to correct your professional omissions as soon as possible.

Please correct my above assertions if you detect any errors so that I may if needed correct my blog and my understanding of your role in this matter. Please respond in a timely manner as I plan to continue making further aspects of these matters part of the public record.
