### Three Strikes and the Students Win

OTTAWA-Severin Stojanovic student faculty rep received high fives today by other Freedom of Expression Committee members following Dean André Lalonde's announcement that he was going to allow Severin to put forward the discussion on the activism course on the faculty council agenda as proposed by Severin in the spring

Severin had threatening to seek legal redress because the Dean was violating the bylaws in disallowing him to bring forward items for discussion at the faculty meeting and neither the senate or board of governors have the authority to intervene.

The Faculty Council meeting scheduled for Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> 11:30 am, Gendron Hall, room GNN 080 is cancelled by Dean André Lalonde for the third time, The reason it was cancelled is that Severin advised the Dean that with the new changes to the agenda Nov 3 he required notice concerning the agenda for the meeting so he could have time to notify his speakers.

The FEC members feel the press release they sent out Nov 2, announcing their intention to attend the council meeting prompted this victory.
