On January 18-23, 2007, the Canadian University Press hosted its 69<sup>th</sup> annual National Student Journalism Conference in Vancouver, British Columbia. Among 360 delegates from 70 campus newspapers was third-year biopharmaceutical-sciences student Maureen Robinson, a writer and executive editor for the University of Ottawa's Fulcrum.

In addition to many other written contributions, Maureen has penned over two dozen science columns for the Fulcrum.

Canadian University Press is the world's oldest student news service. This year's conference featured seminars, workshops, and roundtable discussions on a range of topics including media law, newsroom management, foreign correspondence, investigative journalism, and arts, sports, and feature writing techniques. The keynotes speakers were prominent journalists Ian Hanomansing and Jian Gimeshi, Canadian television icon Dave Foley, and media personality Nardwuar.
