Re: Request for Information Under the Ontario Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act – University of Ottawa File No. AS-159; Your ref: DGR-16

This is in response to your request dated August 7, 2008 in which you had requested access to the following :

«All records related to, about, and/or accompanying Record-2 including but not limited to: all correspondence, any contracts or arrangements to hire services, all internal emails discussing the matter, all records of attempts to secure a transcript, any voice recording, etc.»

A search was undertaken of the records of: Gilles Patry, President (former) Robert Major, Vice-President Academic & Provost, André Lalonde, Dean, Faculty of Science, Deansci, as well as of the Secretary of the University. The keywords utilized in the email search were: "Queen's University", "October 18, 2007", "Rancourt Keynote address". The search took 5 hours. Seven (7) responsive emails were found.

Access is denied to the responsive records in accordance with S.19, S.21 and S.65(6) of the Act. Please refer to the attached index.
